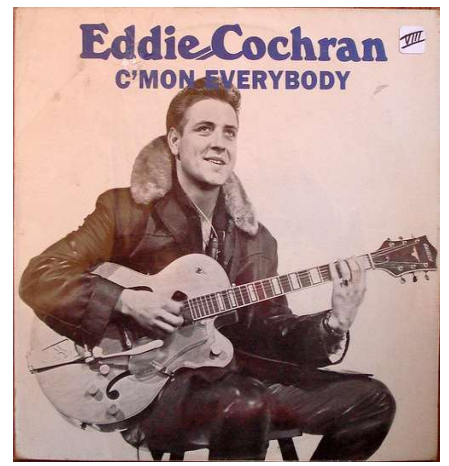


C'MON EVERYBODY
